

United's Employee/Family Scholarship is awarded to a deserving graduating senior that is either employed by the credit union or has a parent that is an employee or member of the board of directors. The selection is based upon scholarship, community involvement, extra-curricular activities during their high school career, written recommendations from teachers or counselors and a written essay. The applicant must have been a member of United Federal Credit Union for at least one year prior to the deadline for the scholarship applications.

Rauen is the daughter of Brian and Angie Lowe of Three Oaks (MI) and Matthew Rauen of Stevensville (MI). Angie is a Member Service Advisor in United's St. Joseph (MI) region.

United also offers a scholarship program for all graduating seniors that have been members of the credit union for at least one year. This year, three scholarships were presented to deserving members, including one \$3000 award and two \$1000 awards.
